In this packet, you will find the description of the various accommodations we have to offer at Winnekeag as well as the Registration Form and Menu. For those seeking a little more comfort and an "off-campus" location, we have prepared a list of area Hotels, Bed and Breakfast Inns and RV Campgrounds. Most of the RV Parks also have rental cabins available.

At this reunion for the second time, we are presenting a couple of options for registration, meal tickets and payment for accommodations:

- 1) <u>Registration forms.</u> The registration form is a PDF that can be downloaded, filled in, and uploaded to return to us by email. It may also be printed and mailed. Completing the registration form will help us provide seating for the correct number of people, even if registrants are not eating or staying overnight onsite. (See below for mailing address)
- 2) <u>Camp accommodations</u>. The camp accommodations do not need to be paid for in advance. You may view the suggested donation rates in the registration packet and pay in advance by mail or in the offering plate on Sabbath. Either way you should check in at the registration table upon arrival.

3) <u>Meal tickets.</u> Meal tickets can be ordered online and paid for in advance (preferred). This works well in connection with emailing your Registration Form. Or you may complete Section B of the Registration Form and mail your payment with the form. Either way, please complete the allergy section on the form if applicable.

We have worked with the cook to prepare a menu that allows us to be efficient in meeting the needs of those with special dietary needs. **Pathfinder Lodge** – Maximum occupancy is 4 individuals per room. \*\* Suggested donation \$25 per person per night or \$75 per immediate family per room

The lodge has two wings, each with seven guest rooms with two sets of bunk beds and a shared shower room on each wing. A large meeting area is located between the two wings featuring a large fireplace. Guests need to bring sleeping bags, pillows, towels, and toiletries. Linens are NOT provided.

 $\it Village\ Cabins\ -**$  Suggested donation \$22 per person per night or \$80 per immediate family per room

Each of the six cabins has two bunk rooms with four twin bunk beds, a counselor room with one bunk bed and a shared half bath. Maximum sleeping capacity is 18 per cabin. Cabins are hardwood floors. Guests need to bring sleeping bags, pillows, towels, and toiletries. Linens are NOT provided. A nearby centralized bathhouse has bathroom, sink and shower facilities.

**RV Sites** – Maximum occupancy is 4 individuals per site.
